£15 annual signing on fee (payable in June/July for existing players or upon becoming a Member of the Club).

£5 per week subscription (payable before commencement of mid-week training session and includes mid-week training session and the following Saturday morning training session).

£25 match kit bond (refundable following the prompt return of the match kit in good condition at the Club's request or upon leaving the club).
